

"The insanthat a blue-gum baboon slashing our Constitution has to prove U.S. citizenshi our silly old Constitution demands – is to absurd to consider in the sacred chamben tiny tin gods of the Potomac, adorning th purple and sipping Jim Jones Kool-Aid.

"Thanks to smug, slimy shysters like you, Obama gets a free ride snootily stomping on our foolish Constitution, which superciliou like you have long ago shredded for their own stupid opinions!" continued in the letter, a copy of which he provided to WND.

He finished with his speculation on what "ought" to happen to th a physical act not appropriate for a family-oriented report.

WND called the U.S. marshals service for comment, but there was comment on the specific case. A WND message left for one of th officers involved also was not returned.

A media <u>office</u> spokeswoman who took the message did confirm "anyone who may write a letter referencing a judge or put sometl letter causing the marshals to be concerned about the well-being judge, they would look into it."

Merrell told WND his particular dislike of "government tyranny' existed "since my fourth-great-grandfather, Captain Benjamin M was hanged – hanged, drawn and quartered – by the British Roya Governor of North Carolina in 1771 for protesting high and unju

In his followup letter to the judge, Merrell's language was a little salty.

"I told your Gestapo goons, of course, that unless the First Amen had been repealed, or they were there to arrest me, that we had no talk about.," Merrell's letter said ."One of your Brown-Shirt Nazi however, could not resist threatening me with some obscure law didn't know where it was, or when it was created – which he said a crime to say something that caused a federal judge 'emotional c

"Emotional distress? What unbelievably unadulterated horses---! Merrell wrote. "What about the repulsive, stomach-turning 'emot distress' you black-robed baboons speciously dish out to the Ame people daily – haughtily spitting on our precious Constitution wi nauseating, decency-stomping, judicial-jack--- slobber! "If it is illegal for a Constitution-loving citizen to chastise a Cons scorning judge, who has spitefully spat on America's consecrated bedrock, then the slimy, steel-laden tentacles of unspeakable tyra already wrapped tightly around helpless citizens – awaiting the fi hideous strangulation.

"But not as long as one end of my red-blooded tongue is loose!" letter said.

He put the challenge directly to the judge:

"The Constitution clearly states, with no possible ambiguity – in 2, Section 1 – that 'No person except a natural born Citizen, or a of the United States, at the time of the <u>Adoption</u> of this Constitutio be eligible to <u>the Office</u> of President," he wrote.

"America is going down the drain – economically and Constitution with terrorists and illegal aliens pouring across our borders like in armies practically unopposed – but our insufferable, over-bloatec dictatorial government, while turning a blind eye to all that, has t money to send two high-paid federal marshals – probably \$130,0 each – to harass a citizen daring to exercise his precious First Amendment rights, which you want to destroy," he wrote.

"When you solemnly swear to uphold and defend the Constitutio loathsomely lacerate and despicably desecrate that hallowed doc perhaps you should fear for your safety, for you have stopped be dutiful servant of the people, and started arrogating unto yourself venomous trappings of their tyrannical slave-master," he wrote.

"Oh, and my ancestor, Captain Benjamin Merrell, wasn't just har but hanged, drawn and quartered: which means he was hanged, b down while yet alive, his <u>abdomen</u> violently sliced open and his er cruelly cut out and brutally thrown in his face and set afire...and body barbarically slashed into four quarters," Merrell wrote. "So naturally, I'm more than a little suspicious of dictatorial power su you brandish. And I'm not alone."

WND reported a challenge to the judge from the lawyer handling <u>case</u>. Robertson threatened attorney John D. Hemenway with san for representing client Gregory S. Hollister. Hollister is a retired

officer subject to being recalled who is demanding to know Obar eligibility to discern whether any orders from the president would legal.

<u>Robertson dismissed the case</u>, ridiculing questions of eligibility *z* already been "blogged, texted, twittered and otherwise massaged

Hollister is represented by Philadelphia lawyer Philip Berg, who brought several motions on the eligibility dispute to the U.S. Sup Court that have been ignored. Hemenway acted as local counsel the action on behalf of Hollister.

Robertson wrote: "The plaintiff says that he is a retired Air Force who continues to owe fealty to his Commander-in-Chief (becausmight possibly be recalled to duty) and who is tortured by uncert to whether he would have to obey orders from Barack Obama be has not been proven – to the colonel's satisfaction – that Mr. Oba native-born American citizen, qualified under the Constitution to president.

"The issue of the president's citizenship was raised, vetted, blogg texted, twittered, and otherwise massaged by America's vigilant (during Mr. Obama's two-year-campaign for the presidency, but t plaintiff wants it resolved by a court," Robertson wrote.

Hemenway has responded with a suggestion that if the judge war pursue sanctions, the attorney then would seek a discovery <u>hearing</u> demand the president's original birth certificate as court procedur would allow.

The clients concerns also are valid, he wrote.

"These are not frivolous matters, as the learned Judge Robertson suggested. Possible illegal orders are a matter of great concern to in the armed forces. ... The legality of orders in and out of comb paramount importance," he wrote.

The lawyer also criticized the judge for citing hearsay in his cour opinion.

"It is not helpful for a United States district judge to endorse obfu

when a constitutional issue is involved. Under these circumstance threaten sanctions against an attorney who, in good faith assisted filing of a lawsuit involving issues none of the many judges and attorneys from coast to coast have found 'frivolous' is to employ 11 as a device to deprive the undersigned attorney of his civil rig the right to due process. Without even a hearing or access to disc being granted to defend against the charges, such a sanction wou veritable lynching," Hemenway challenged.

"If the court persists in pressing Rule 11 procedures against Hem then Hemenway should be allowed all of the discovery pertinent procedures as court precedents have permitted in the past," he sai

"The court has referred to a number of facts outside of the record particular case and, therefore, the undersigned is particularly enti hearing to get the truth of those matters into the record. This may the court to authorize some discovery," Hemenway said.

WND has reported on dozens of legal challenges to Obama's stat "natural born citizen." The Constitution, Article 2, Section 1, stat Person except a natural born Citizen, or a Citizen of the United S the time of the Adoption of this Constitution, shall be eligible to Office of President."

Some of the lawsuits question whether Obama was actually born Hawaii, as he insists. If he was born out of the country, Obama's American mother, the suits contend, was too young at the time of to confer American citizenship to her son under the law at the tin

Other challenges have focused on Obama's citizenship through h a Kenyan subject to the jurisdiction of the United Kingdom at the his birth, thus making him a dual citizen. The cases contend the f of the Constitution excluded dual citizens from qualifying as natu born. Further complicating the issue are the reports he was adopt Indonesia man during his childhood and moved to Indonesia and attended school there. There also are questions on what nation's J he traveled to Pakistan.

Lawyers and plaintiffs in a multitude of lawsuits also have asked a birth certificate actually reflects that Obama was born in Hawai spent sums estimated by observers of up to \$1 million hiring vari <u>firms</u> to keep concealed his birth certificate, his college records an <u>documentation</u>.

John Eidsmoe, an expert on the U.S. Constitution now working v Foundation on Moral Law, told WND a demand for verification Obama's eligibility appears to be legitimate.

Eidsmoe said it's clear that Obama has something in the documen of his history, including his birth certificate, college records and documents that "he does not want the public to know."

Although Obama officials have told WND all such allegations ar "garbage," here is a partial listing and status update for some of t over Obama's eligibility:

- <u>New Jersey attorney Mario Apuzzo</u> has filed a case on behal Charles Kerchner and others alleging Congress didn't proper ascertain that Obama is qualified to hold the office of presid
- Pennsylvania Democrat Philip Berg has three cases pending including Berg vs. Obama in the 3rd U.S. Circuit Court of A a separate Berg vs. Obama which is under seal at the U.S. D Court level and Hollister vs. Soetoro a/k/a Obama, (now dis brought on behalf of a retired military member who could be recall to active duty by Obama.
- Leo Donofrio of New Jersey filed a lawsuit claiming Obama's citizenship disqualified him from serving as president. His c considered in conference by the U.S. Supreme Court <u>but der full hearing.</u>
- Cort Wrotnowski filed suit against Connecticut's secretary o making a similar argument to Donofrio. <u>His case was consic conference</u> by the U.S. Supreme Court, but was denied a ful hearing.
- Former presidential candidate Alan Keyes headlines a list of filing a suit in California, in a case handled by the United St Justice Foundation, that asks the secretary of state to refuse the state's 55 Electoral College votes to be cast in the 2008 presidential election until Obama verifies his eligibility to he office. The case is pending, and lawyers are seeking the pub support.

- Chicago <u>attorney</u> Andy Martin sought legal action requiring F Gov. Linda Lingle to release Obama's vital statistics record. case was dismissed by Hawaii Circuit Court Judge Bert Aya
- Lt. Col. Donald Sullivan sought a temporary restraining ordestop the Electoral College vote in North Carolina until Barac Obama's eligibility could be confirmed, alleging doubt abou Obama's citizenship. His case was denied.
- In Ohio, David M. Neal sued to force the secretary of state t request documents from the Federal Elections Commission, Democratic National Committee, the Ohio Democratic Party Obama to show the presidential candidate was born in Hawa case was denied.
- Also in Ohio, there was the Greenberg v. Brunner case whic when the judge threatened to assess all case costs against the plaintiff.
- In Washington state, Steven Marquis sued the secretary of st seeking a determination on Obama's citizenship. The case w denied.
- In Georgia, Rev. Tom Terry asked the state Supreme Court 1 authenticate Obama's birth certificate. His request for an inju against Georgia's secretary of state was denied by Georgia S Court Judge Jerry W. Baxter.
- California attorney Orly Taitz has brought a case, Lightfoot Bowen, on behalf of Gail Lightfoot, the vice presidential can on the ballot with Ron Paul, four electors and two registered
