It is essential that we make assimilation of our legal immigrants a top priority and learning English is **Step #1** in that process. It requires all official functions of the United States government to be conducted in English. It establishes a uniform language requirement for naturalization. Finally, it places an obligation on representatives of the federal government to encourage individuals to learn and use English.

Yet, despite vast bipartisan support for English becoming the official language of the United States, that is — **89 percent of Republicans, 59 percent of Democrats, 74 percent of Independents, and even 76 percent of Hispanics** — there is a powerful lobby of multilingual groups fighting to do great harm to our democracy and to our political institutions by...

- ◆ Filing law suits to overturn states that have voted and passed legislation making English the official language.
- ◆ Suing small business owners who require their employees to speak English.
- ◆ Forcing taxpayers to fund bilingual education in many public schools.

Unfortunately, the efforts of the politically correct, multilingual lobbies (like the ACLU) have already had devastating effects as they push us to be a divided nation. Here's what they've done to America in just a short period of time:

- ◆ Passed a Federal law REQUIRING STATES to print election ballots in foreign languages.
- ◆ The Equal Employment Opportunity Commission has sued organizations, like the Salvation Army, for requiring their employees to speak English in the work place.
- ◆ As widely reported, driver's license exams are now given in foreign languages in almost 90% of the United States; in as many as 30 different languages.

But their assault on our American identity doesn't end there.

The grave threat is immigrants not assimilating into American culture — **their**

unwillingness to speak English and our Political leaders making taxpayers foot the bill, so they don't have to assimilate!

Incredibly, our opponents are trying to use the coronavirus pandemic as an excuse to dramatically *expand* taxpayer-funded multilingual policies for people who live in the U.S. yet refuse to learn English.

Assimilation is not *just* important — it is essential. Immigration without assimilation is invasion!

Consider the impact of NOT assimilating:

- According to the 2012 Census, the assistance offered by social welfare programs is being utilized **by 75% of legal and illegal immigrant families** — the latest sign that many immigrants come to America for the taxpayer-funded benefits like Medicaid, subsidized food, and cash.
- National Review researchers estimated that 6.4% of the estimated 11 million illegal immigrants — roughly 700,000 people — cast votes in recent U.S. elections.
- A disproportionate number of murderers, rapists, and drug dealers are crossing into the U.S. — illegal immigrants are three times as likely to be convicted of murder as members of the general population and account for far more crimes.

This is bad for our identity as Americans; it is bad for the American culture, and bad for the American political system.

I don't believe that the Federal Government — **AND OUR TAX DOLLARS** — should be used to further a radical agenda that embraces official multilingualism (a divided America) or threatens to block Official English laws that have already been passed in 32 states.

BE IT MATTER OF PUBLIC RECORD, there is vast bi-partisan support for English becoming the official language of the United States – 89 percent of Republicans, 59 percent of Democrats, 74 percent of Independents, and 76 percent of Hispanics agree.

BE IT MATTER OF PUBLIC RECORD, a growing and gathering threat to Americans are policies that will defund border security, grant amnesty to illegal aliens and increase “chain migration,” the primary mechanism that has caused an estimated 11 million illegal aliens into our country -- quadrupling over the last 40 years.
