





# RESOLUTION NO. 10-79

## FORMATION OF PROPERTY RIGHTS ADVISORY COUNCIL

**WHEREAS**, the Bonner County Board of Commissioners recognizes there is a need to form a property rights advisory council; and

**WHEREAS**, the primary function is to examine ways to promote and protect private property rights by reviewing county relevant State and National law with federalist principles to determine which legal functions are better performed and transferred locally; and

**WHEREAS**, members of the council must exhibit an understanding of the principles and policies which underwrite federalist government structure as they pertain to empowering smaller orders of government to protect and promote private property rights; and

**WHEREAS**, it would be in the best interest of Bonner County to establish a County Property Rights Advisory Council and appoint a nine (9) member advisory committee representing one member from the County Commissioners office, the others to consist of citizens of the community; and


**WHEREAS**, this board will forward its recommendations to the Bonner County BOCC who will consider forwarding these recommendations to the appropriate Idaho Association of Counties (IAC) and National Association of Counties (NACO), or other appropriate organizations for their input and potential advocacy to the State and National legislatures and shall conduct its activities pursuant to the attached Exhibit A.


