Dear WRIA17 & CAPR & WA Senators and Representatives and Enumclaw Herald and King County Journal:

I would like to amplify what Ron has so clearly and eloquently stated below in his email below and seven points. His points are worthy of THINKING IT OVER. I hope you like Buddy Holly it may help you wade through this rant. Turn up your sound.

How many times do the rural and urban property owners, the grass root organizations, associated businesses, civic organizations and all the people living in the country and working in the cities have to keep painting this picture for the city, county, state and federal government bodies? The environmental group think has so infested the government and society that they are blind to simple facts. They simply cannot and will not understand that the environmental movement has long since moved from any sense of need and balance to

becoming some of the most radical, destructive and self promoting ideology today. Let us not feel sorry any longer for the spotted owl! It time for the government to set up special private property wilderness areas for exclusive USE of private property owners. We should elicit the help of our 1000 Friends in WA and CELP and Nature Conservancy and call Paul Allen and ask for a few hundred million to buy up and set aside our own land from the southern border to northern border, from the Cascades west to the Sound as a national preserve for endangered species of private property owners. We could petition both of our environmental loving senators and they would most assuredly get us on the endangered species farmers list. Once on this endangered list we would be protected from the likes of Ron Sims and his county council gang not too mention the Department of Ecology. People from the city could drive out on Sundays when it wasn't raining and we could all put on our bib overalls and go out and work the fields so they would feel good about preserving the way it use to be. Answering that simple question will tell you how embolden and distorted this type of environmental and political group think has become. It shows you how far this sustaining development taking has spread. When the high courts in large part takes property rights and the cities take private land through distortion of eminent domain and distortion of environmental cause then you have started to experience tyranny. When city

and county council set about to further themselves by taking private occupied land to further the city over respecting individual privacy and constitutional rights as in New London you have to start paying attention to why your cities are creeping up to your back door. You definitely do not want to THINK IT OVER.

The majority of urban property owners do not even know what CAO means and if they do, it is simply something to do with clean air and clean water. Again the complete truth never gets told or understood or nobody cares or all of the above. That is why Ron Sims get voted in for the third time. Elected officials reflect the consciousness and thinking of the community. THINK IT OVER even though it may make you ill.

After you connect enough dots to the cities and to the environmentalist you will see a picture which you are experiencing right now. A picture that Ron Ewart has been writing and preaching about forever. The title of the picture is SUSTAINING DEVELOPMENT, SMART GROWTH, CONTROLLED GROWTH and it comes from the UNITED NATIONS. There is an Office of Sustaining Development in Washington DC and in many major city mayor offices including Seattle. What you have here is what Patrick Michaels (Research Professor of environmental sciences at UV & author of "Meltdown") calls a "paradigm-political" process. This is a positive feedback loop, e.g. a snow ball going down hill in wet snow. You have a government and environmental lobby and academia and even most embarrassing, scientific journals that perpetuate this urban myth of environmental fear and scarcity to perpetuate the funding and existence of themselves. When the power of the government becomes so pervasive that it is the major source of funding for many areas of research, especially environmental studies, then you can start to understand why large government organizations like WA Department of Ecology and DDES and elected offices such as our WA states governor office and our two Senators are part of the environmental myth and problem and not part of the solution. What should be the source of the solution has evolved into the source of the problem.

Recent election results here in King County and WA state although discouraging regarding the continued takings are not the total picture. Under the table of takings by the cities you see a new picture. A growing numbers of hundreds of property and water rights groups and other groups are fighting to take back all of their freedoms and liberties they have been loosing over the last 30 years. American are slow to react but we are sponge like. You can drip water or whatever fluid or brown matter you imagine on us for a long long time and then one day you start to see what is dripping in is gushing out. We are becoming saturated with too much nanny government, too much nanny tree hugging environmental sue happy groups like "1000 Friends/Enemies of Washington/FutureFear' and "CELP - Center for Environmental Law and Policy Perversion". Who has to take any time to decide an issue when you see someone from FutureFear or "CelpUSScrewThem" push another lawsuit over on

the local property owners... I mean do we really even need to THINK IT OVER in this case?

Rural people want to be left alone. We have had it with the DOE, EPA, ESA, DDES, CAO, GMA and PBRS and Ron Sims and the rest of the bloated government planning and enforcement offices and those people who have nothing better to do than sit around and plan your future. No agency of the government or environmental lobby will be able to move one step forward any longer without all of the property and water rights groups and anyone who has an ounce of common sense descending upon them in mass. The age of environmental innocence is over. You don't have to think this over unless you are in the city maybe?

Another point to note is the obvious. We surely know that the majority in control in King County and Olympia reflect only the city side of this state not the country. The majority in this state and the corresponding big city counties reflect and vote for the distorted environmental group think including our two Senators and at least half the legislature into office. There is no balance in this state. This includes both parties who are primarily city oriented. Thus the great lose of our Steve Hammond. The majority in this state live in the contiguous King, Snohomish, Pierce and Thurston counties.
